PASTOR'S CORNER – Is There a Purpose Behind Suffering?

Some might suppose that hardships or tragedies are a result of God bringing about such things for a form of Divine Judgement. But when you examine God's doing such things in the past you will quickly see that each time He has announced His forthcoming actions (Flood, Sodom, leaving Egypt, Israel's captivity, etc.). In today's world we have no oracles of prophecy to tell us He is at work. In our post-Christ era God is focused on our individual lives. In Heb 12 we read that God disciplines us because He loves us – not wanting any to perish (2 Peter 3:9). During Christ's ministry He indicated that some tragedies (Luke 13:1ff) are not God's handiwork. Here, the passage of Rom 8:28 declaring that God will work all things together for good may have more relevancy. He does not cause to happen but causes to bring resolution.

Many things happen because there are evil people behind such atrocities. That is why Paul tells us that the civil authorities have the responsibility of bearing the sword to bring wrath upon evildoers (Rom 13:4). Additionally, the Book of Revelations reveals that even the world's authorities may at times be evil themselves and God will wreck justice at the right time. Thankfully Christ Himself warns us that there **will be troubles** in this world – but He has overcome (John 16:33). In **John 9:1ff** Jesus told His disciples that a blind man was in his situation in order that the works of God might be displayed in him. Similarly, Lazarus's death & resurrection occurred so that the glory of God and the Son of God might be displayed (John 11:4). You will notice how the Lord's work has shifted the focus in these situations to explain what "purpose" was being served. This means that these situations were not some kind of punishment but an opportunity.

When difficulties enter into our lives, rather than speculate about God's involvement, let us strive to see what lessons we can learn from these situations and see how we can serve Him and bring glory to Him. Let us bring our situations, good and/or bad, into opportunities to glorify God.
