Pastor Corner of Light - John 3:16 B

Many see in John 3:16 the important message of salvation because of God's love and Jesus' sacrifice. But there is one tiny nugget of truth there that is often not given proper consideration – those who reject the blood of Christ will pay the penalty of perishing. We will all face judgment during the reading of the Book of Life. Revelations 20 tells us: v.10 “And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone...” v.12 “And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened which is the Book of Life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.” V. 15 “And if anyone's name was not found written in the Book of Life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.” Mtt 7:21-23 & Luke 13:22-28 tell different stories of those who think they have a connection with the Lord but will find themselves (like the 5 Virgins, Mt 25:1-13) out in the cold – but not the cold. Lk 13:27, 28 tells the end of those without a relationship with Jesus: “and He will say: ‘I tell you, I do not know where you are from; Depart from Me, all you evildoers.’ In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth...” In Jhn 17:15 Jesus prays to the Father that He protect us from the evil one and in Mt 10:28 Jesus warns His followers “Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.” Many might see in this verse a reference to Satan who can, if possible, lead us down the wide path to destruction but the Hebrews write says in 10:31, “It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God.” But, it is only terrifying if we appear before Him without the benefit of Christ's sacrificial and atoning blood. THAT – is why God, out of His great love for us, sent His Son so that we will have ETERNAL LIFE. Destruction: Mtt 3:12, 5:22,29, 8:12, 10:28, 12:32,41,42, 13:40,41,49,50 Mtt (cont.) 18:9, 22:13,14, 25:41,45,46 and Lk16:19-31 (rich man/ Lazarus)
